

Cheap shots

A video camera is a fantastic gadget to have – capturing all those special or funny moments can be priceless.

Aussie company Kogan continues to release products that are inexpensive and feature-packed.

The latest offering is the Kogan 1080p Touch Video Camera.

It retails for \$329 and records footage straight to an 8-megabyte SD memory card that is included.

The USB cable lets you plug it straight into your PC and download the .MOV/QuickTime format movies.

If you want to plug the camera into your TV, a HDMI cable is included.

The 3" LCD touchscreen makes it a breeze to access and watch your recorded footage.

The video camera is also a still



camera and can take pictures up to 10 megapixels in resolution.

The camera shoots video in a number of resolution options, such as 720psi and 1080psi, and 50xZoom (5x Optical Zoom and 10x Digital Zoom).

The Optical Image Stabiliser is nice to have when you need to have a steady hand to record, but I would still use a tripod if you need a still shot.

If you don't have a video camera or your old one still uses VHS tapes, the time might be right for you to jump into the digital age.
